Educational assistants provide support for all students to be included in the class- room and school, implement lesson and behavioural plans for students as directed by the teacher, motivate and encourage students to participate in learning activities, assist students who have physical and personal care needs, administer oral tests or act as a scribe for students and support students to develop healthy relationships at school.
